The next information session is February 20 at Pinetree Secondary (Cafeteria/Multi-Purpose Room), followed by a session after the PD day on February 28 and a virtual session on March 4.


School District Budget

The Winter Representative Assembly was held on January 31st-February 1st at the River Rock Casino in Richmond.
Representatives from all over the province gathered together to discuss and vote on important motions for our union.

One of the major issues discussed was the recent move by the Minister of Education & Childcare to dismiss all of the Greater Victoria School Board Trustees and replace them with an unelected manager over a policy disagreement about discontinuing the use of Police Liaison Officers in Victoria schools. We voted to denounce the move and a statement has already been issued which can be found on the BCTF website.

The Provincial Bargaining Team has assembled and they have begun preparing for their meetings with the employer. There will be more updates as bargaining sessions commence, so check back and make sure the CTA has your personal email address.

On a local note, delegates to the upcoming Canadian Teachers Federation AGM were elected and Sandra Cowan, a Coquitlam teacher, was among the delegates chosen. - Ben Whipps


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


